Dr Kent Woo

Dr Woo graduated from Jefferson Medical College of Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia. After receiving his MD degree; he obtained his Internal Medicine residency training at Eastern Virginia Medical School where he was nominated by his peers to serve as Chief Resident of Internal Medicine. He was then appointed as Assistant Professor of Medicine and started the academic hospitalist program at Norfolk General Hospital.

After the academic hospitalist program became a success, Dr. Woo pursued further subspecialty training in the field of Allergy and Immunology. He became a fellow in training at Louisiana State University under the mentorship of Dr. Sami Bahna, an internationally recognized figure in food allergy and past president of the American College of Allergy, Asthma and Immunology. Upon completion of his fellowship training, Dr. Woo worked as an Allergist in Allergy & Asthma Care Centers in Northern Virginia. There, he played an integral role in developing their state-of-the-art immunotherapy program.

Professor Dr Lee Way Seah started his career at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital for Children in 1994. His area of expertise is paediatrics (paediatric gastroenterology, Hepatology, and nutrition). He is a member of national and international professional organisations including serving as the President of the College of Paediatrics, Academy of Medicine, Malaysia, an Editorial Board Member of the International Seminars of Paediatric Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition. He coauthored Handbook of Hospital Paediatrics, 2005, Vol. 1, Kuala Lumpur, published by Unipress, and has contributed to many academic journals including the Annals of the Academy of Medicine, Singapore, Journal of Clinical Pharmacy and Therapeutics, and the World Journal of Gastroenterology. He has received a scholarship from the Association of Commonwealth Universities and is a Fulbright Scholar.

Dr Leong Kin Fon is a Paediatric Dermatologist. He went on to qualify as a Paediatrician (MRCPCH) from the University of Edinburgh, Scotland. He later underwent Paediatric Dermatology training since 2005 in Kuala Lumpur General Hospital of Malaysia, Hospital Charite in Berlin, Germany, National Taiwan University and Changi General Hospital of Singapore. Dr Leong completed his Paediatric Dermatology training in 2010. In addition, his academic appointments include Honorary Lecturer at the Faculty of Medicine, University Perdana and Paediatric Dermatology Sub-speciality Trainer of National Health Ministry, Malaysia. He has contributed a chapter on Pigmentary Disorder among Asian Children in a book called Paediatric Skin of Colour and the main author of a hand book called Atopic Excema and Psoriasis in Children.
